the Octagon



The octagon style will create a scenic focal point for your backyard, your place of business (as a break area), or a community garden. You have the added benefit of extending your existing entertaining space beside, or on your deck or patio, or nestled in a more private part of your garden. Whether your need is a place for personal relaxation, a family picnic dining area, or the setting for a celebration or memorable party, the octagon will suit your needs and living style beautifully.

The octagon gazebo is the most basic gazebo that we offer. But with a broad variety of options to choose from, it is also one of our most popular. The gazebo above is an 8' gazebo with cedar shake shingles and benches on 6 sides.

The 14' vinyl gazebo shown on the cover is shown with 36" rails, synthetic cedar shake shingles, a double roof, and a screening package.

the **Octagon** *Bell Roof*

Adding a unique touch to the octagon, the bell roof is a great way to accentuate your investment. The defined details and structural elements of the curved roofline are reminiscent of the 19th century and are similar to the Queen Anne style of architecture. This style was an important detail of the affluent homes and buildings of that era.

Our gazebos offer you the option of choosing between the simple symmetrical lines of the standard rails and posts, or the more ornate victorian look with turned balusters and posts. The vinyl gazebos shown on this page are in white vinyl, which is our standard color. You may consider upgrading to an ivory or clay colored vinyl to match or coordinate with the color of your home. The gazebo on the left has had the runners removed and has been screwed to the decking underneath. You will have your choice of decking colors and architectural shingles. All octagon gazebos come standard with a cupola.

the **Octagon** *steep roof*



The gazebo shown at left is a 10' vinyl octagon with a steep roof, and charcoal gray metal roofing.

the **Octagon** *steeple roof*

The 14' vinyl gazebo below features a steeple roof with charcoal shingles, and a screening package. This gazebo was custom built to create a seamless flow from the deck to the gazebo.



Like the featured unit, all of our gazebos can be ordered with a screening package.

the Oval

Whether you want to add to your existing landscape, or if you want to embellish your lawn with a graceful center piece, the

aesthetically pleasing oval gazebo makes a stunning addition to any location that it graces with its presence.



This 12x16 vinyl gazebo is shown with screens and features a double roof.
(all of our screened gazebos come with a door)

The 10 x 16 vinyl oval pictured to the right features our screen option. The rubber slate roof shingles are made of synthetically engineered, recycled materials making them an environmentally friendly, light weight alternative to slate.



the Rectangle

Featuring a simplistic, four-sided design, the rectangle allows you to maximize interior space, without sacrificing the refined look of the exterior.



The 12x20 vinyl rectangle above features a double roof with synthetic red slate shingles and a screening package.

The 12x14 vinyl rectangle shown below features vinyl windows and pewter gray shingles.



The 10x12 wood rectangle shown above is our basic rectangle model. The featured gazebo is shown with benches.

the Dodecagon

The definition of a dodecagon is simply a 12-sided shape. We have applied this shape to our gazebos which results in a more rounded structure. Any gazebo that is 12' in diameter or larger can be ordered as a dodecagon. The gazebo on the right is a larger structure more suited to a public area or larger property.



The 20' vinyl dodecagon pictured above features victorian braces, screening, and a triple roof with charcoal shingles.



This dodecagon is smaller in size, but still just as impressive as the larger ones. It is perfect for the average yard or limited space areas. The gazebo shown is a 12' wood dodecagon. It features a double roof, turned posts and balusters, and franklin white paint.

the Dodecagon Pavilion

Capture many moments in time while enjoying this wonderful backyard oasis. Whether you want a place to entertain your guests, or you simply

need a quiet, relaxing haven, the dodecagon accomplishes both while bringing timeless beauty to your home.

The gazebo featured to the left is a 20' wood dodecagon pavilion. It is shown with clay paint, turned balusters, our electrical package, and a double roof with weatherwood shingles.



the Pavilion

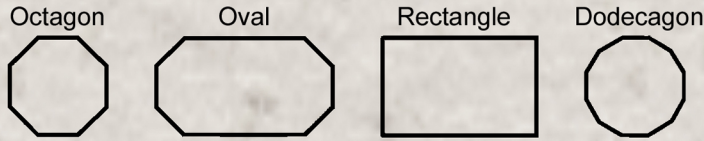
18x36 double roof pavilion with 10' posts and 42" rails.



Not for the faint of heart, the pavilion gazebo is a massive beauty that is sure to be appreciated by all. This size lends itself perfectly to be used in public places such as parks, schools, resorts, golf courses or any other large area of recreation. They have larger posts, rails and braces to withstand the repeated public use that is expected of them. Due to their size, they must be built on site.

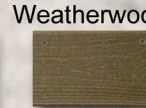

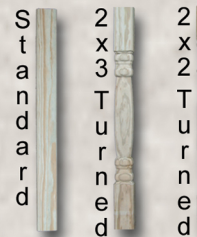

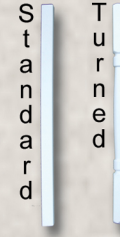


4.) Choose your baluster and post style. The standard baluster for a wood gazebo is a 1x3 baluster, or you can upgrade to 2x2 or 2x3 turned baluster. The standard baluster for a vinyl gazebo is 2x2 square baluster, or you can upgrade to a 2x2 turned baluster.

6.) Choose your brace style.



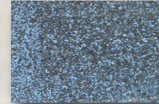
7.) Choose your roof style.

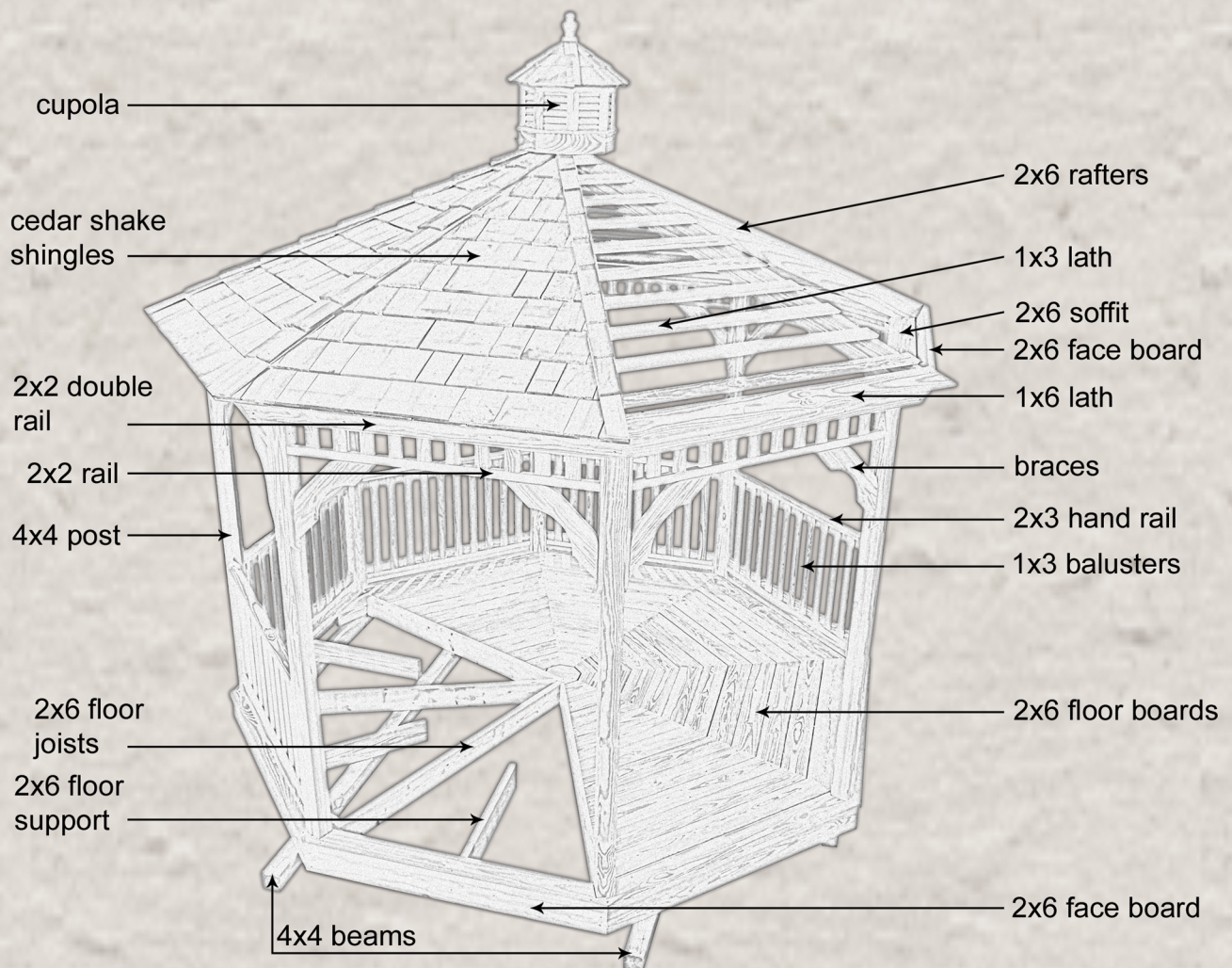
9.) Choose any additional options:

Construction

All of our gazebos are designed and built with the highest quality materials and structural longevity in mind. We start by using pressure treated 4x4 beams as a base. On top of these beams we install 2x6 upright floor joists which are then covered with 2x6 floor boards. This creates a stable foundation for your gazebo. The posts are then inserted into precut holes, after which rails are added to the posts. To ensure quality, the roof is constructed on the ground with 2x6 rafters. When the framework for the roof is complete, we install 1x3 molded lath boards. These lath boards are then covered with cedar shake shingles.

For vinyl gazebos, the rafters are covered with ½" sheeting. The shingle of your choice is installed on top of the sheeting. The interior of the ceiling is then covered in vinyl. This method of construction creates a roof that looks just as good inside as it does on the outside.

Finally, we anchor the roof to the posts. This entire process results in a gazebo that you can depend on to last and enjoy for many years to come!



the Sunroom

The sunroom pictured is a 14' octagon. It is shown with custom vinyl siding, dark gray synthetic slate shingles, triple roof, copper roof cupola, custom glass inserts in the triple roof, and a custom door.



The Sunroom will allow you to create your own personal outdoor retreat. Whether to house a hot tub or some comfortable chairs, you're sure to appreciate the privacy and serenity that the sunroom offers. You'll enjoy the added benefit of using your Sunroom year round, as it is totally enclosed, offering protection from harsh winter winds or a spring rain. Unlike an enclosed porch, the Sunroom has large 40 x 60 windows on 7 sides allowing you to enjoy your surroundings from every angle. Along with other options, you may choose to have a finished interior. Remember the way you felt the last time you visited a solarium? Now imagine owning one of your very own.
